This is a full camping weekend so you will need to bring everything for yourself and your horse, we will be camping at White Woman's Waterhole which has plenty of trees for night lines and areas to set up portable yards, water is available at the waterhole but if you are able to bring water for your horse do so as the waterhole is not full at the moment, however there are fire dams all through the forest for the horses to drink from while out riding. (Club will bring water pumps)

For those wanting to arrive on Friday afternoon Len and Margaret will be there from 3pm onwards with signs out.

Yarrum township is only a 20 minute drive from the camp if you are needing supplies or wanting a pub dinner for tea Saturday night.

Riding is mostly flat sandy tracks with some opportunities for some nice canters. Saddlebag lunches will be needed, Saturdays ride will leave at 10 am and cover about 25 km's with Sundays ride being a bit longer depending on how everyone is feeling, maybe up to 35 km's.

Mondays ride will depend on tide times, we will be needing to pack up camp and float horses 30 -40 km's to a surprise beach location where we will be doing a short ride of about 10 km's, this will give people a chance for an early drive home.

For those travelling along the Princess Highway travel to Traralgon and turn right heading towards Yarrum via The Hyland Highway (C482) , approximately 47 km's to Won Wron, look for the sports oval on the right and just past here turn left into Napier Road (CFA and Public Hall on the corner). Drive 5 km's down Napier Road and White Woman's Waterhole is on the left.

For those travelling along the South Gippsland Highway towards Sale, turn left into The Hyland Highway (approximately 1km out of Yarrum) towards Traralgon , about 8.3 km's along turn right into Napier Road (Auburn Vale Jersey Stud is .5 k on the left before Napier road). White Woman's Waterhole is 5 km's down on the left.
