## Australian Endurance Riders Association Rule Book

This months snip it: **33. Riding the Course**

**33.3** Riders must ride the course as marked within the maximum permitted riding time.

### ERRORS FOLLOWING THE COURSE

**33.4** If a rider makes an error in following the course as marked, the rider may:

- a) correct the error by riding the portion(s) of the course not previously ridden pursuant to clauses 33.7 to 33.8 inclusive or
- b) Withdraw from the ride in accordance with Clause 34.

**33.5** The rider who fails to correct their error and who chooses not to withdraw shall be eliminated by the Chief Steward for "Failure to ride the course as marked".

## ATHRA Rule Book

This months snip it: **New Changes to Code of Conduct**

**3.1** Each affiliated club may have additional rules consistent with this Code of Conduct, but all provisions of the Code have precedence and must be complied with. All ATHRA members should make themselves familiar with these rules and conduct themselves so as to do justice to the noble art of horsemanship and the promotion of ATHRA and its ideals.

**3.2** Where a club reasonably anticipates that any planned trail ride or event will attract 80 or more participants, the club shall notify their Regional Manager of this at least six (6) weeks prior to the event. The Regional Manager shall liaise with the club to ensure that adequate and appropriate safety protocols are in place.

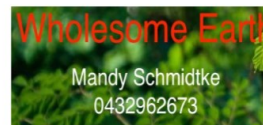

Moringa Olifera is a highly valued tree native to the Sub-Himalayan tracts of India, Pakistan, Bangladesh and Afghanistan and is planted around the world. The tree is cultivated as a vegetative crop and is evergreen and fast growing with high capability to regrow after pruning. Many parts of the Moringa are cooked in various ways around the world.
