

## List of Requirements

### These conditions are part of our Ride Risk Assessment Plan

<b>Ride Register:</b>	<p>Due to COVID-19 we will not have a physical ride register before the ride and will consider your RSVP email/text message as confirmation of attendance.</p> <p>When you attend a ride with Tinderry Trail Horse Riders Inc you are agreeing to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• abide by the ATHRA Code of Conduct and the Rules and Regulations of Tinderry Trail Horse Riders Inc.</li> <li>• accept all reasonable directions given to you by ride officials during the course of the trail ride.</li> </ul>
<b>Helmets:</b>	<p>All junior riders (under 18) MUST wear AS/NZ 3838 or ASTM F 1163 helmets that are no more than five years old.</p> <p>All riders of young/inexperienced trail horses, particularly horses new to riding with groups, are also asked to wear a helmet to the above standard.</p>
<b>Code of Conduct</b>	Participants will be required to adhere to the <a href="#">ATHRA Code of Conduct</a> .

## Ride Information

<b>Start Time:</b>	<b>9:00am</b> for a <b>9:30am</b> ride start
<b>Directions:</b>	<p><b>From Canberra:</b> Micalago Rd is on the east side of the Monaro Highway 1km south of the Michelago Service station. Once on Micalago Road travel approximately 5.7km (7 minutes) until you get to a cattle grid with a white timber gate on the left. Immediately after the cattle grid turn left into the paddock where you will see a Tinderry Trail Horse Riders sign and a mowed area for floats/trucks/cars.</p>
<b>Ride Description:</b>	The ride duration is approximately 5 hours and 15 – 20kms long. The ride will be through mostly undulating country with some woodland.
<b>Ride Difficulty:</b>	Fairly easy but traveling at a fast-walking pace.
<b>Ride Warnings/Alerts:</b>	There may be small creek crossings and some gullies to cross. Cattle, sheep and Kangaroos can be found in the paddocks and possibly pigs or deer.
<b>Grid/Map/GPS reference:</b>	See above for directions
<b>Estimated Duration:</b>	Approximately 5 hours including stops for morning tea and lunch
<b>First Aid:</b>	A basic first aid kit will be carried on the ride
<b>Emergency Contact:</b>	There will be good mobile phone coverage available during this ride

<b>Horse Fitness:</b>	Moderate – the ride is approximately 15 – 20kms and the ride will travel at a fast walk.
<b>Catering:</b>	BYO morning tea, lunch and drinking water in saddle bags
<b>Equipment:</b>	Bring headstalls and lead ropes for tying or leading horses
<b>Horse feed:</b>	BYO feed if required
<b>Water Availability:</b>	Dams and creeks are available throughout the ride. No water available at the float parking area.
<b>Horse Shoes:</b>	It is recommended that horses are shod. Unshod horses must be sufficiently conditioned to cope with the ride terrain and the duration. If your horse is unshod we recommend that you carry hoof-boots.
